#### PHOTO HIGHLIGHTS ON SENSORY EXPLORATION





### STEPHEN WILTSHIRE

Stephen Wiltshire, a British architectural artist, is renowned for his extraordinary ability to draw detailed cityscapes from memory. Diagnosed with autism at the age of three, he initially struggled with speech but found a way to express himself through art. His incredible talent has gained worldwide recognition, leading to prestigious commissions and exhibitions. In 2006, he was appointed a Member of the Order of the British Empire (MBE) for his contributions to the arts. Wiltshire's journey highlights the remarkable abilities of autistic individuals and has helped to challenge misconceptions about autism, promoting greater awareness and appreciation of neurodiversity.
