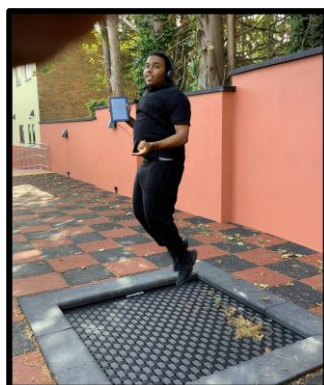
THE BRIDGE SEN SCHOOL CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION

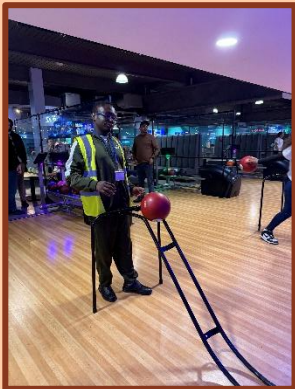
